

A Note From Pastor Gary.....

I've always thought April Fools ought to be the day after Easter. Jesus returns from the dead and says, "April Fools"! I'm no longer dead but alive forevermore!

Christ is risen! He is risen indeed! Alleluia! Now what do we do? The month of April reminds us that Easter is *more than just one day*. Easter is an "every day" celebration in which we live each day trusting in God through Christ, knowing that Jesus is "the resurrection and the life.

So what do we do now as we go forth from the empty tomb? Let us follow the example of the first witnesses of the empty tomb. After the two angels reminded Mary Magdalene, Joanna, Mary the mother of James, and the other women that Jesus had risen, St. Luke tells us that "they remembered the words, and returning from the tomb they told all these things to the eleven and to all the rest" (Lk 24:8-9, emphasis mine). They went forth from the tomb changed by the resurrection of Jesus. They went forth from the tomb to bring an "every day" witness of God's power over Sin, death, Hell, and Satan himself.

So where do we go once we leave the empty tomb? They went back to their vocations or stations in life and took the witness of the resurrection with them. The disciples went back to their vocations and lived in the joy of the resurrection of Jesus while carrying out the daily,

ordinary lives.

Similar to the women at the empty tomb and the eleven disciples, we are "every day" witnesses and participants in the resurrection of Jesus. We believe and are baptized. We have the hope of eternal life. We have the joy of the resurrection *living* inside of us. Also, like the women at the empty tomb and the eleven disciples, we have vocations or stations in life that God has given to us as gift. Most of us are not fishermen, but all of us have one or more of these callings: father, husband, mother, wife, son, daughter, brother, sister, grandparent, employee, retiree, friend, and neighbor. Each of these callings comes with a set of duties and responsibilities. As repentant Christians, by God's grace we wrap the daily duties and responsibilities of our vocations in the joy, love, peace, and forgiveness of Christ.

Now, we go forth from Easter Sunday and the celebration of the empty tomb free as God's forgiven children in Christ. Now we go forth empowered by God's Spirit living and active within us to live in the joy of the resurrection as "every day" witnesses.

Instructions for Using Tithely

Here are some instructions on using tithely. The QR code can be found on the front page of the bulletin, the financial page of the newsletter and on facebook.

When you link through the QR code or website link, you will be taken to the giving screen. You can opt to sign-up, or just to enter each time to click on the link/QR code. If you sign up, you will simply log in and all your information will auto fill the screen. By signing up, Tithely will keep track of your givings.

You will enter the amount of your giving, and then click the "Fund" Drop Down Box to designate where your gift goes. You have the option of choosing to make this gift a One Time gift, or you can set it up to be recurring - Weekly, Bi-weekly, 1st and 15th, or monthly. Then you will enter your name, email address and phone number. And, then click on "Add Payment Method". Click on Card or US Bank Account and enter your card or blank account information here.

There is a small fee (3.14%) for each transaction. This can be paid by the giver, or it will be paid by the church. Choose Yes or No if you would like to cover the fee. You can add a comment or instructions for your gift in the memo section.

At the bottom of the screen is the total amount of your gift. Check on the "Give" button to complete your transaction. You will receive an email confirmation of your gift.


